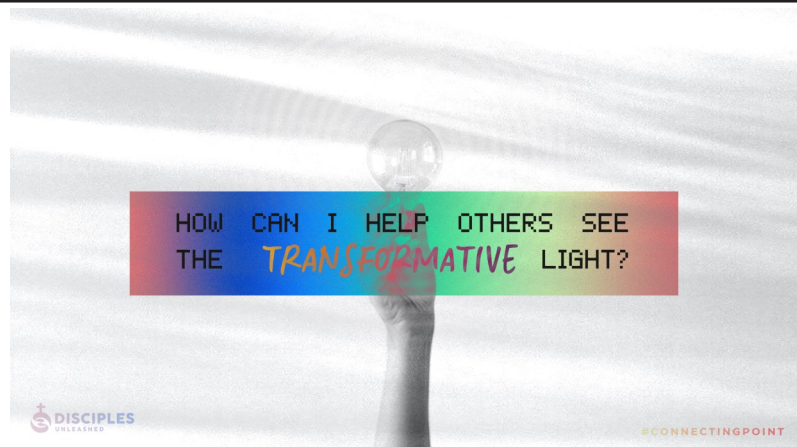
#### Connecting point...

##### How can I help others see the transformative light?

One day, I was setting up my new router after cutting ties with cable and diving into the wonderful world of streaming TV. As part of that process, I had to connect my TV and computer to Wi-Fi. Without entering a passcode or connecting to Wi-Fi, I would never have been able to receive signals in response to my searches.

The Gospel for the second week of Lent focuses on the transfiguration of Jesus. The disciples were able to witness the divine glory of Jesus, but more importantly, they were given hope in times of darkness. As disciples, their task was to receive God's signal and use it to help others see the transformative light. We, too, are disciples called to unleash the Gospel and are reminded to live as examples of faith, trust, and divine transformation. We can guide others by demonstrating a

##### ¿Cómo puedo ayudar a otros a ver la luz transformadora?

Un día, estaba configurando mi nuevo enrutador después de cortar los lazos con el cable y sumergirme en el maravilloso mundo de la transmisión de TV. Como parte de ese proceso, tuve que conectar mi televisor y mi computadora a Wi-Fi. Sin ingresar una contraseña o conectarme a Wi-Fi, nunca habría podido recibir señales en respuesta a mis búsquedas.

El Evangelio de la segunda semana de Cuaresma se centra en la transfiguración de Jesús. Los discípulos pudieron presenciar la gloria divina de Jesús, pero lo más importante es que recibieron esperanza en tiempos de oscuridad. Como discípulos, su tarea era recibir la señal de Dios y usarla para ayudar a otros a ver la luz transformadora. Nosotros también somos discípulos llamados a difundir el Evangelio y se nos recuerda que debemos vivir como ejemplos de fe,

life centered on Christ, and by trusting in God's promises, we can inspire hope in those who struggle with doubt. We can reflect His light to those in darkness, but first, we need to be open to receiving His "Wi-Fi signal" by "entering our passcode" through prayer so that God can reveal Himself to us.

The second reading features God speaking with Abram, calling him to trust in something beyond his understanding. God asked him to look up and try to count the stars, which represented his many descendants. Interestingly, the Lord told Abram to do this during the day. Abram couldn't see the stars during the day, but the Lord was trying to teach him that he would need faith and trust in Him; the descendants would be there even if he couldn't see them! This passage is another reminder that transformation begins with trust—trust in God's plan, even when the path is unclear. Like Abram, we must trust in God's promises, and like the disciples, we must open our minds and hearts to connect to God's "Wi-Fi signal" through prayer so we can listen to His voice. Then, we can share this light by encouraging faith in others, walking with them in their doubts, and reflecting God's presence with our words and actions. Transformation happens when we witness God's power and share that vision with those around us. This Lenten season, come into the desert with us, walk the Stations of the Cross, and share meals with us to connect with your fellow disciples. Connect with God so that you, too, may go out and help others see the transformative light within you!

confianza y transformación divina. Podemos guiar a otros demostrando una vida centrada en Cristo y, confiando en las promesas de Dios, podemos inspirar esperanza en quienes luchan con la duda. Podemos reflejar Su luz a quienes están en la oscuridad, pero primero, debemos estar abiertos a recibir Su "señal de Wi-Fi" "ingresando nuestra contraseña" a través de la oración para que Dios pueda revelarse a nosotros.

La segunda lectura presenta a Dios hablando con Abram, llamándolo a confiar en algo más allá de su entendimiento. Dios le pidió que mirara hacia arriba e intentara contar las estrellas, que representaban a sus numerosos descendientes. Curiosamente, el Señor le dijo a Abram que hiciera esto durante el día. Abram no podía ver las estrellas durante el día, pero el Señor estaba tratando de enseñarle que necesitaría fe y confianza en Él; ¡los descendientes estarían allí incluso si él no pudiera verlos! Este pasaje es otro recordatorio de que la transformación comienza con la confianza: confianza en el plan de Dios, incluso cuando el camino no está claro. Al igual que Abram, debemos confiar en las promesas de Dios y, al igual que los discípulos, debemos abrir nuestras mentes y corazones para conectarnos a la "señal de Wi-Fi" de Dios a través de la oración para que podamos escuchar Su voz. Luego, podemos compartir esta luz alentando la fe en los demás, caminando con ellos en sus dudas y reflejando la presencia de Dios con nuestras palabras y acciones. La transformación ocurre cuando presenciamos el poder de Dios y compartimos esa visión con quienes nos rodean. En esta Cuaresma, ven con nosotros al desierto, recorre el Vía Crucis y comparte comidas con nosotros para conectarte con tus compañeros discípulos. ¡Conéctate con Dios para que tú también puedas salir y ayudar a otros a ver la luz transformadora que hay en tu interior!
