Connecting point...

How can I practice humility in my daily interactions?

Palm Sunday begins Holy Week with a striking contrast—Jesus is welcomed into Jerusalem with cheers and palm branches, but by the end of the week, those same crowds call for His crucifixion. The readings this coming weekend, especially the Passion narrative from Luke, invite us to pause and reflect on Jesus' humility through it all.

Though He is the Son of God, Jesus chooses to ride into the city on a donkey—not on a horse with soldiers accompanying Him, but in peace and simplicity. Later, as He is betrayed, denied, beaten, and crucified, He never lashes out. Instead, He prays for forgiveness for those who hurt Him. That is humility.

So, how can we live that out in our own small ways?

¿Cómo puedo practicar la humildad en mis interacciones diarias?

El Domingo de Ramos inicia la Semana Santa con un marcado contraste: Jesús es recibido en Jerusalén con vítores y palmas, pero al final de la semana, esas mismas multitudes piden su crucifixión. Las lecturas de este próximo fin de semana, especialmente el relato de la Pasión de Lucas, nos invitan a detenernos y reflexionar sobre la humildad de Jesús a pesar de todo.

Aunque es el Hijo de Dios, Jesús decide entrar en la ciudad en un burro, no a caballo con soldados acompañándolo, sino en paz y sencillez. Más tarde, al ser traicionado, negado, golpeado y crucificado, nunca arremete. En cambio, ora pidiendo perdón para quienes lo lastimaron. Eso es humildad.

Entonces, ¿cómo podemos vivirlo en nuestras propias pequeñas formas?

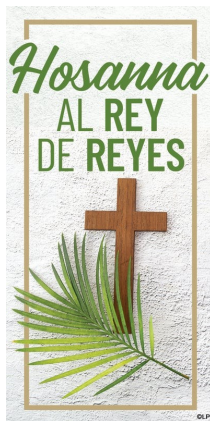
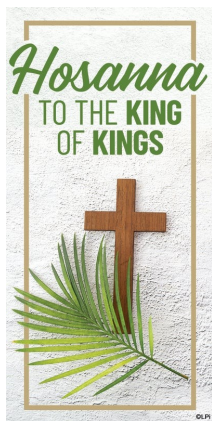

Humility doesn't mean thinking less of ourselves; it means thinking of ourselves less. It's choosing to listen before speaking. It's being willing to admit when we're wrong or when we don't have all the answers. It's noticing the needs of others—even in small ways, like letting someone go ahead in line or offering a smile when someone looks down.

In conversations, humility might look like asking questions instead of jumping to conclusions. At work or school, it might be sharing credit or offering help without needing recognition. At home, it might mean apologizing first or forgiving quickly.

Jesus shows us that humility isn't weakness—it's strength under control. This Holy Week, as we walk with Him to the cross, let's ask ourselves: Where can I choose to be more humble? During my day, how can I make room for others and God?

Small acts of humility, repeated often, shape us and open our hearts to love more like Christ—gently, patiently, and with grace.

La humildad no significa menospreciarnos; significa pensar menos en nosotros mismos. Es elegir escuchar antes de hablar. Es estar dispuesto a admitir cuando nos equivocamos o cuando no tenemos todas las respuestas. Es reconocer las necesidades de los demás, incluso en los detalles más pequeños, como dejar que alguien avance en la fila u ofrecer una sonrisa cuando alguien mira hacia abajo.

En las conversaciones, la humildad puede consistir en hacer preguntas en lugar de sacar conclusiones precipitadas. En el trabajo o la escuela, puede consistir en compartir el mérito u ofrecer ayuda sin necesidad de reconocimiento. En casa, puede significar disculparse primero o perdonar rápidamente.

Jesús nos muestra que la humildad no es debilidad, sino fuerza bajo control. Esta Semana Santa, mientras caminamos con Él hacia la cruz, preguntémonos: ¿Dónde puedo elegir ser más humilde? Durante mi día, ¿cómo puedo hacer espacio para los demás y para Dios?

Pequeños actos de humildad, repetidos con frecuencia, nos moldean y abren nuestros corazones para amar más como Cristo: con gentileza, paciencia y gracia.

Food Pantry News

As always, I want to thank you, our parishioners for continuing to support our mission of helping our neighbors in need. April 3rd, we were able to help 23 families with food and other household and hygiene items. We sometimes forget that even if they do receive some type of government assistance, it is not enough to get them through the month. Even with Bridge Cards, Food stamps and WIC programs, they are not able to purchase toilet paper, kleenex, feminine hygiene items, cleaning supplies, laundry soap and dish soap. **Current Needs: instant potatoes, stuffing mix (all kinds) rice-a-roni, pancake mix, syrup, tuna fish, spaghetti sauce, large chicken soup, coffee, tea, laundry and dish soap.** Remember we are an equal opportunity provider.

Como siempre, quiero agradecerles a ustedes, nuestros feligreses, por seguir apoyando nuestra misión de ayudar a nuestros vecinos necesitados. El 3 de abril, pudimos ayudar a 23 familias con alimentos y otros artículos para el hogar y la higiene. A veces olvidamos que, aunque reciban algún tipo de ayuda del gobierno, no es suficiente para cubrir sus gastos mensuales. Incluso con las Tarjetas Puente, los Cupones de Alimentos y los programas WIC, no pueden comprar papel higiénico, pañuelos desechables, artículos de higiene femenina, productos de limpieza, jabón para la ropa y lavavajillas. **Necesidades actuales: papas instantáneas, mezcla para relleno (todo tipo), arroz a la roni, mezcla para panqueques, jarabe, atún, salsa para espagueti, sopa de pollo grande, café, té, jabón para la ropa y lavavajillas.**

Recuerde que somos un proveedor que ofrece igualdad de oportunidades.

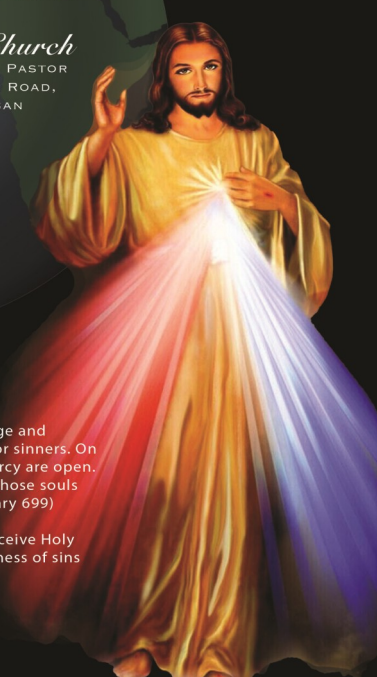
