

### Connecting point...

#### Hope in Him.

Pope Francis has declared 2025 as the "Jubilee Year of Hope." Hope is at the heart of who we are as a Christian people, and Christ's Resurrection is our source of hope. The Resurrected Christ is the Light that overcomes the darkness of our world. His Resurrection gives us the hope that God's grace is more powerful than sin, life is more powerful than death, and hate will be overcome by love. The empty tomb means new beginnings for all of creation (a message reflected in the tapestries on the west wall of St. Isidore's worship space).

We are called to live in this new creation. Our hope is for a better world with a better future for refugees, the poor, the sick, the lonely, the depressed, the abused, the paranoid, and the downtrodden. As Christian people of hope, it is our mission to do all that we can to create this new world. Thus, Easter is not just a day—it is a way of life.

In his first letter to the Corinthians, St. Paul speaks of our hope that arises from Christ's Resurrection. Notice that he does not write, "Therefore, since you have such a great hope, sit back and relax because God has a great future in store for you." Instead, he writes, "Therefore, my beloved ones, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, because you know that in the Lord your labor is not in vain" (1 Corinthians 15:58).

At Mass today, we distributed Easter cards with this Connecting Point, "Hope in Him." The card, created by our Director of Engagement, Matt Kush, displays a powerful design for which he offers the following reflection:

This year's Easter card features a darker design than usual, but that's intentional. In a world that often feels heavy with division, fear, and uncertainty, the dark background represents the reality of those struggles. But from that darkness,

### Punto de conexión...

#### Esperanza en Él

El Papa Francisco ha declarado 2025 como el "Año Jubilar de la Esperanza". La esperanza está en el corazón de lo que somos como pueblo cristiano, y la resurrección de Cristo es nuestra fuente de esperanza. El Cristo Resucitado es la Luz que vence las tinieblas de nuestro mundo. Su resurrección nos da la esperanza de que la gracia de Dios es más poderosa que el pecado, la vida es más poderosa que la muerte y el odio será vencido por el amor. La tumba vacía significa nuevos comienzos para toda la creación (un mensaje reflejado en los tapices de la pared oeste del espacio de culto de San Isidoro).

Estamos llamados a vivir en esta nueva creación. Nuestra esperanza es un mundo mejor con un futuro mejor para los refugiados, los pobres, los enfermos, los solitarios, los deprimidos, los maltratados, los paranoicos y los oprimidos. Como pueblo cristiano de esperanza, nuestra misión es hacer todo lo posible para crear este nuevo mundo. Por lo tanto, la Pascua no es solo un día, es una forma de vida.

En su primera carta a los Corintios, san Pablo habla de nuestra esperanza que surge de la resurrección de Cristo. Nótese que él no escribe: "Por lo tanto, ya que tienes una esperanza tan grande, siéntate y relájate porque Dios tiene un gran futuro reservado para ti". En cambio, escribe: "Por tanto, amados míos, estad firmes e inmutables, abundando siempre en la obra del Señor, porque sabéis que en el Señor vuestro trabajo no es en vano" (1 Corintios 15:58).

En la Misa de hoy, distribuimos tarjetas de Pascua con este Punto de Conexión, "Esperanza en Él". La tarjeta, creada por nuestro Director of Engagement, Matt Kush, muestra un potente diseño para el que ofrece la siguiente reflexión:

La tarjeta de Pascua de este año presenta un diseño más oscuro de lo habitual, pero eso es intencional. En un mundo que a menudo se siente cargado de división, miedo e incertidumbre, el fondo oscuro representa la realidad de

light breaks through. The glowing doorway is a powerful symbol of the stone rolled away, not from the outside looking in, but from inside the tomb looking out—as if we're seeing the moment Jesus steps into the light of Resurrection. The beam of light stretching forward reminds us that hope doesn't stay buried; it moves with us. Paired with the message, "Hope in Him," this card is a reminder that Easter is more than a day—it's an invitation to walk forward in the light of Christ, even when the world feels dark.

We hope that you will put the card in an accessible place where you may see it and reflect on it daily. May it encourage you to live each day in the hope of the Resurrected Christ.

esas luchas. Pero de esa oscuridad surge la luz. La puerta resplandeciente es un poderoso símbolo de la piedra removida, no desde el exterior mirando hacia adentro, sino desde el interior de la tumba mirando hacia afuera, como si estuviéramos viendo el momento en que Jesús entra a la luz de la Resurrección. El haz de luz que se extiende hacia adelante nos recuerda que la esperanza no permanece enterrada; se mueve con nosotros. Junto con el mensaje "Esperanza en Él", esta tarjeta es un recordatorio de que la Pascua es más que un día: es una invitación a caminar hacia adelante en la luz de Cristo, incluso cuando el mundo se siente oscuro.

Esperamos que coloque la tarjeta en un lugar accesible donde pueda verla y reflexionar sobre ella a diario. Que os anime a vivir cada día en la esperanza de Cristo Resucitado.

**Food Pantry News**

As always, I want to thank you, our parishioners for continuing to support our mission of helping our neighbors in need. April 3<sup>rd</sup>, we were able to help 23 families with food and other household and hygiene items. We sometimes forget that even if they do receive some type of government assistance, it is not enough to get them through the month. Even with Bridge Cards, Food stamps and WIC programs, they are not able to purchase toilet paper, kleenex, feminine hygiene items, cleaning supplies, laundry soap and dish soap. **Current Needs: instant potatoes, stuffing mix (all kinds) rice-a-roni, pancake mix, syrup, tuna fish, spaghetti sauce, large chicken soup, coffee, tea, laundry and dish soap.** Remember we are an equal opportunity provider.

Como siempre, quiero agradecerles a ustedes, nuestros feligreses, por seguir apoyando nuestra misión de ayudar a nuestros vecinos necesitados. El 3 de abril, pudimos ayudar a 23 familias con alimentos y otros artículos para el hogar y la higiene. A veces olvidamos que, aunque reciban algún tipo de ayuda del gobierno, no es suficiente para cubrir sus gastos mensuales. Incluso con las Tarjetas Puente, los Cupones de Alimentos y los programas WIC, no pueden comprar papel higiénico, pañuelos desechables, artículos de higiene femenina, productos de limpieza, jabón para la ropa y lavavajillas. **Necesidades actuales: papas instantáneas, mezcla para relleno (todo tipo), arroz a la roni, mezcla para panqueques, jarabe, atún, salsa para espagueti, sopa de pollo grande, café, té, jabón para la ropa y lavavajillas.** Recuerde que somos un proveedor que ofrece igualdad de oportunidades.
