Connecting point...

I remember the collective gasp, even if not audible, when the world first heard about St. Mother Teresa's "dark night," a fifty-year period of feeling God's absence from her life. Some said that the book *Mother Teresa: Come Be My Light: The Private Writings of the "Saint of Calcutta"* shouldn't be published. As a matter of fact, she herself had asked for the writings to be destroyed upon her death, likely because of a fear that these letters and other private writings might bring doubt to others. In the end, we can never know the full effect of the book's publication, but we *do* know that the book reveals that doubt is a very human condition with the ability to affect almost anyone.

In our scripture readings for today, Thomas refuses to believe in the Resurrec-

Recuerdo la conmoción colectiva, aunque no audible, cuando el mundo escuchó por primera vez sobre la "noche oscura" de la Santa Madre Teresa, un período de cincuenta años en el que sintió la ausencia de Dios en su vida. Algunos decían que el libro " *Madre Teresa: Ven a ser mi luz: Los escritos privados de la "Santa de Calcuta"* " no debía publicarse. De hecho, ella misma pidió que los escritos fueran destruidos tras su muerte, probablemente por temor a que estas cartas y otros escritos privados pudieran sembrar dudas en otros. Al final, nunca podremos conocer el impacto total de la publicación del libro, pero *sí* sabemos que revela que la duda es una condición muy humana, capaz de afectar a casi cualquier persona.

En nuestras lecturas bíblicas de hoy, Tomás se niega a creer en la Resurrección

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tion until he sees Jesus with his own eyes. Once he does, his doubt disappears. Our maxim for the week, "no doubt," reflects the moment when Thomas moves from skepticism to a firm declaration of "My Lord and my God!" What a blessing! Thomas gets firm proof of Jesus' Resurrection by seeing the evidence for himself. Jesus knows, however, that many disciples will have to believe *without* seeing for themselves. He goes on to say, "Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed." These words serve as our call to cast doubt aside and hold firm to our belief in Jesus for our sake and the sake of our community.

It is this communal aspect of faith that served as one of the reasons that, while St. Mother Teresa didn't want her writings to outlive her, the Vatican wanted them preserved. They saw how her perseverance through the dark night of her soul models the hanging on, trusting, and forging ahead that we are all called to at different times in our lives. Furthermore, her life also affirms for us, on this Divine Mercy Sunday (and always), that God's mercy and love can work through us, even when we feel like life is uncertain.

Just as St. Mother Teresa and other committed Christians serve as role models for us, it is good to remember that we can also be models of faith for others. On our strong days, we carry others along on our shoulders. On days when we falter, we grab the hands of our brothers and sisters of faith, allowing them to lift us up. Together, may our collective demonstration and witness of faith in Jesus proclaim "No doubt!" in our skeptical world today.

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hasta ver a Jesús con sus propios ojos. Una vez que lo hace, su duda desaparece. Nuestra máxima de la semana, "sin duda", refleja el momento en que Tomás pasa del escepticismo a una firme declaración de "¡Señor mío y Dios mío!". ¡Qué bendición! Tomás obtiene una prueba firme de la Resurrección de Jesús al ver la evidencia por sí mismo. Sin embargo, Jesús sabe que muchos discípulos tendrán que creer *sin* ver por sí mismos. Continúa diciendo: "Bienaventurados los que no han visto y han creído". Estas palabras nos llaman a dejar de lado las dudas y a mantenernos firmes en nuestra creencia en Jesús por nuestro bien y el de nuestra comunidad.

Este aspecto comunitario de la fe fue una de las razones por las que, si bien la Santa Madre Teresa no quería que sus escritos la sobrevivieran, el Vaticano quería que se conservaran. Vieron cómo su perseverancia en la oscuridad de su alma ejemplifica la perseverancia, la confianza y la perseverancia a las que todos estamos llamados en diferentes momentos de la vida. Además, su vida también nos confirma, en este Domingo de la Divina Misericordia (y siempre), que la misericordia y el amor de Dios pueden obrar a través de nosotros, incluso cuando sentimos que la vida es incierta.

Así como la Santa Madre Teresa y otros cristianos comprometidos nos sirven de modelo a seguir, es bueno recordar que también podemos ser modelos de fe para los demás. En nuestros días de fortaleza, cargamos con el apoyo de otros. En los días de flaqueza, nos tomamos de la mano de nuestros hermanos y hermanas de fe, permitiéndoles que nos levanten. Que juntos, nuestra demostración colectiva y testimonio de fe en Jesús proclame "¡Sin duda!" en nuestro mundo escéptico de hoy.- **Peggy Casing, Directora de Formación de Discipulado**

Food Pantry News

"Problem turned to Blessing" Mercy in Action

Recently our food pantry faced a difficult situation. One of our pantry clients had a dilemma and our group went into action to help her. She arrived to pick up her food by "Lyft." After her food had already been placed in their car, for some reason the driver told her he could not wait to take her home and unloaded all the food and supplies and left her sitting outside our pantry. It would have cost her over \$50.00 to get a ride back home. We are not able to deliver to our clients, but after some discussion, it was decided that 2 of us would take her home. When we arrived, we were shocked to see that the only furniture in the entire apartment were 2 old office chairs and a partially deflated blow up mattress. Despite this, she was so very grateful for the ride home.

When we arrived back at the pantry and shared with our fellow workers what we had found, our group went into action and developed a plan to help her. One person was put in charge to coordinate the plan. One person's son had a couch and an end table she could have. The following Tuesday, two of our men picked up the couch for delivery and when the K of C members from St. Kieran's came to deliver their Food Drive Collection, they saw the couch and asked if we needed furniture. We shared with them the story of our client. He said he had 2 living room chairs and a lamp that he could donate. One of our men followed him home and retrieved the items. Another one of our workers had a bed and dresser. She was also able to furnish it with a mattress pad, new sheets and a comforter. Someone else had a microwave, another worker purchased a set of silverware for her, another provided quarters for the laundry mat in her complex. Another provided cleaning supplies. Another bought bathroom supplies. Another provided towels, a shower curtain, etc. When they delivered to her that day, they set everything up for her including making her bed.

We were so blessed to have been put in this situation. It put our minds at ease knowing that she would no longer be sleeping on that deflated air mattress and could be comfortable in her new surroundings.

It is amazing to see how God turned a difficult situation into such a blessing for all.
God's work is never done.

"Problema convertido en bendición" Misericordia en Acción

Recientemente, nuestra despensa de alimentos enfrentó una situación difícil. Una de nuestras clientas tenía un dilema y nuestro grupo se puso en marcha para ayudarla. Llegó a recoger su comida en Lyft. Después de que ya habían colocado la comida en el coche, por alguna razón, el conductor le dijo que estaba impaciente por llevarla a casa, descargó toda la comida y los suministros y la dejó sentada fuera de la despensa. Le habría costado más de \$50.00 el viaje de regreso. No podemos hacer entregas a domicilio a nuestros clientes, pero después de hablarlo un rato, decidimos que dos de nosotras la llevaríamos a casa. Al llegar, nos sorprendió ver que los únicos muebles en todo el apartamento eran dos sillas de oficina viejas y un colchón inflable parcialmente desinflado. A pesar de esto, estaba muy agradecida por el viaje.

Cuando regresamos a la despensa y compartimos con nuestros compañeros lo que habíamos encontrado, nuestro grupo se puso en marcha y desarrolló un plan para ayudarla. Una persona se encargó de coordinar el plan. El hijo de una persona tenía un sofá y una mesa auxiliar que ella podía usar. El martes siguiente, dos de nuestros hombres recogieron el sofá para entregarlo y, cuando los miembros de los Caballeros de Colón de St. Kieran's vinieron a entregar su colecta de alimentos, lo vieron y nos preguntaron si necesitábamos muebles. Les contamos la historia de nuestra clienta. Dijo que tenía dos sillas de sala y una lámpara que podía donar. Uno de nuestros hombres lo siguió a casa y recuperó los artículos. Otra de nuestras trabajadoras tenía una cama y una cómoda. También pudo amueblarla con un cubrecolchón, sábanas nuevas y un edredón. Otra tenía un microondas, otra trabajadora le compró un juego de cubiertos, otra proporcionó espacio para la lavandería de su complejo. Otra proporcionó artículos de limpieza. Otra compró artículos de baño. Otra proporcionó toallas, una cortina de ducha, etc. Cuando le entregaron el sofá ese día, lo prepararon todo, incluso le hicieron la cama.

Nos sentimos muy afortunados de haber estado en esta situación. Nos tranquilizó saber que ya no dormiría en ese colchón de aire desinflado y que podría estar cómoda en su nuevo entorno.

Es asombroso ver cómo Dios transformó una situación difícil en una bendición para todos.
La obra de Dios nunca termina.
