

Connecting point...

When have my words become stones?

We all remember the old phrase, "Sticks and stones may break my bones, but words will never hurt me." However, the truth is that words can hurt...and sometimes do even worse.

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus is confronted with a crowd ready to stone a woman caught in sin. He challenges them with these words: "Let the one among you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone." Slowly, they drop their stones and walk away. But I wonder: How often do we throw stones with our words?


¿Cuándo mis palabras se han convertido en piedras?

Todos recordamos la vieja frase: "Los palos y las piedras pueden quebrarme los huesos, pero las palabras nunca me harán daño". Sin embargo, la verdad es que las palabras pueden herir... y a veces incluso peor.

En el Evangelio de este domingo, Jesús se enfrenta a una multitud dispuesta a apedrear a una mujer sorprendida en pecado. Los reta con estas palabras: «El que esté libre de pecado, que tire la primera piedra». Lentamente, dejan caer las piedras y se marchan. Pero me pregunto: ¿Con qué frecuencia tiramos piedras con nuestras palabras?

Lanzamos piedras cuando chismeamos y cuando criticamos a alguien por ira,

We throw stones when we gossip and when we tear someone down out of anger, jealousy, or frustration. We also throw stones when we label people unfairly, when we make assumptions, and when we refuse to give someone the benefit of the doubt. Furthermore, we throw stones when we let division, politics, or pride push us into judging others harshly—sometimes without even knowing the full story.

In today's world, those stones are everywhere. Social media and public conversations are full of them. So often, we speak without mercy, patience, or kindness. And the damage goes far beyond broken bones; it breaks trust, divides families, creates enemies out of neighbors, and silences those already struggling.

But Jesus calls us to something radically different. He doesn't just tell the crowd to put down their stones; He responds to the woman with mercy. He doesn't ignore her sin, but He also doesn't shame or condemn her. He simply says, "Go, and from now on do not sin anymore."

That's the other part of this equation. It's not just about stopping the hurtful words; it's about replacing them with words that heal, forgive, and show mercy—words that build up instead of tear down.

Right now, when there's so much division, anger, and blame in our world, this message couldn't be timelier. Before we speak (or comment, criticize, or post on social media), we need to ask ourselves, "Am I throwing stones with my words?" And if we've hurt someone, "Am I willing to offer words that heal?"

This week, let's pay attention to the words we use—both in person and online. Let's drop the stones we're tempted to throw, instead choosing words of compassion, patience, and mercy.

celos o frustración. También lanzamos piedras cuando etiquetamos a las personas injustamente, cuando hacemos suposiciones y cuando nos negamos a darle a alguien el beneficio de la duda. Además, lanzamos piedras cuando dejamos que la división, la política o el orgullo nos impulsen a juzgar a los demás con dureza, a veces sin siquiera conocer la historia completa.

En el mundo actual, esas piedras están por todas partes. Las redes sociales y las conversaciones públicas están llenas de ellas. Con mucha frecuencia, hablamos sin piedad, paciencia ni amabilidad. Y el daño va mucho más allá de las fracturas; destruye la confianza, divide familias, crea enemigos entre los vecinos y silencia a quienes ya están pasando apuros.

Pero Jesús nos llama a algo radicalmente diferente. No solo le dice a la multitud que deje las piedras; responde a la mujer con misericordia. No ignora su pecado, pero tampoco la avergüenza ni la condena. Simplemente dice: «Vete, y de ahora en adelante no peques más».

Esa es la otra parte de la ecuación. No se trata solo de detener las palabras hirientes; se trata de reemplazarlas con palabras que sanen, perdonen y muestren misericordia; palabras que edifiquen en lugar de destruir.

Ahora mismo, con tanta división, ira y culpa en nuestro mundo, este mensaje es muy oportuno. Antes de hablar (o comentar, criticar o publicar en redes sociales), debemos preguntarnos: "¿Estoy tirando piedras con mis palabras?". Y si hemos herido a alguien, "¿Estoy dispuesto a ofrecer palabras que sanen?".

Esta semana, prestemos atención a las palabras que usamos, tanto en persona como en línea. Dejemos de lado las piedras que nos tientan a lanzar y, en su lugar, elijamos palabras de compasión, paciencia y misericordia.


